Zach also noted that the family was clearly suffering from hard times and the mother was forced to wash the family's clothing by hand and hang the clothes to dry because her washer and dryer were broken. Zach recognized that this mother was doing everything she could to make the best possible life for her family given the limited resources available.

Zach took it upon himself to organize an impromptu relief effort by collecting donations from fellow employees of the Police Department. Zach found a nearly new washer and dryer. Using his own money and money donated by his fellow GPD employees, Zach purchased the washer and dryer. Zach then enlisted the help of his fellow shift mates to deliver and donate the appliances to this family in need. The mother of five now has more time to spend nurturing her children. Without Zach's intervention, this would have never happened.

This specific example is only glimpse into the character and generosity displayed by Officer Zach Parker on a daily basis.
