A RESOLUTION TO APPROVE THE TRANSFER OF THE LAKEVIEW SCHOOL FROM THE CAMPBELL COUNTY SCHOOL DISTRICT TO THE CITY OF GILLETTE AND TO PROVIDE FOR THE OPERATIONS AND MAINTENANCE COST OF THE LAKEVIEW SCHOOL FOR AT LEAST FIVE YEARS

WHEREAS, the Governing Body for the City of Gillette, Wyoming has applied for a Community Facilities Grant And Loan Program from the Wyoming Business Council to assist in financing the Gillette Youth Learning Center operated by the Boys and Girls Club; and

WHEREAS, the Campbell County School District has agreed to deed the Lakeview School to the City of Gillette, to be repurposed to be the Gillette Youth Learning Center and operated by the Boys and Girls Club; and,

WHEREAS, the City of Gillette and the Campbell County School District have entered into an agreement, the Lakeview School Site Memorandum of Understanding, (MOU), that includes the transfer of the Lakeview School to the City of Gillette; and,

WHEREAS, the City of Gillette agrees to provide for the operations and maintenance costs of the Lakeview School for a period of at least five years after the completion of all improvements funded through the Wyoming Business Council.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE City of Gillette, Wyoming:

1. To approve the transfer of the Lakeview School from the Campbell County School District according to the terms of the Lakeview School Site Memorandum of Understanding

2. To provide for the operations and maintenance costs of the Lakeview School for a period of at least five years after the completion of all improvements funded through the Wyoming Business Council.

3. To direct the City Administrator to reflect this maintenance commitment in the budget to be prepared for fiscal 2014/2015 and succeeding years.
