Flood Zone Descriptions

Zone A: An area inundated by 100 year flooding, for which no BFEs have been established. Corresponds to the 1% annual chance floodplain. Base Flood Elevations (BFE).

Zone AE: An area inundated by 100-year flooding, for which BFEs have been determined. Corresponds to the 1% annual chance floodplain.

0.2 Percent Anual Chance Flood Hazard (100-year flood)

Zone X

An area that is determined to be outside the 100- and 500-year floodplains.



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


