RE: Mt Pisgah Well No. 4 Replacement

Mr. Hamilton,

The purpose of this letter is to request approval to re-drill the Cemetery District's Water Well No. 4 located in the west-central area of the Mt Pisgah Cemetery. Currently Well No. 4 at Mt. Pisgah is experiencing operational problems that do not allow us to use it to full potential; therefore re-drilling this well is needed. Per previous discussions with City Staff and Administration, the Cemetery District is in the process of upgrading various irrigation facilities to improve our water efficiency and minimize our use of City Water for irrigation purposes. Please consider this letter to be the District's application in accordance with Chapter 12 of the City Code.

Notification of Nearby Property Owners:

Attached to this letter is a map and list of addresses of all property owners within five hundred feet of the proposed well. All property owners have been mailed a notification that well drilling operations are planned nearby.

Well Construction and Contracting Details:

- In contracting for this project, the District will utilize the City's standard construction contract (City of Gillette 2012 Standard Specifications) which includes provisions for licensure, bonding and insurance.
- The attached drawings and details show the location and installation details for this
 well.
- Water needed for drilling operations will be obtained from another well at Mt Pisgah (Well #2) or from other sources arranged by the contractor.
- Water generated from well development and testing operations will be discharged to cemetery grounds or to the south property line (I-90 ROW) as was done on previous drilling projects.
- Drill cuttings and mud will be contained on-site and disposed of properly and surfaces will be restored to existing or better conditions.
- Drilling operations are proposed to occur 24 hours per day as has been done on previous City and District well drilling projects.
- No City streets, alleys or roads will be blocked. Contractor will access the site through the main entrance to Mt Pisgah off 8th Street and the south entrance off Flying Circle.

The above information addresses the major items of concern listed in Chapter 12. The Campbell County Cemetery District hereby requests approval of this well drilling activity and a waiver of the requirement for a deposit for this drilling project.


We look forward to successful completion of this project this spring. Please contact the Cemetery District with any questions.








MT. PISGAH NO. 4 REPLACEMENT WELL PROJECT


500 FOOT RADIUS FROM NEW WELL

APRILLIAN TO FOR TEMPORARY CHANGE IN LOCATION OF WELL

TEMPORARY CHANGE IN WELL LOCATION. The division superintendents are suthorized no use temporary changes of location for ground water wells for short periods of time (up to a maximum of one year). The affected ground water right must be a valid appropriation. If a well is involved which is located in a ground water control area, the superintendent may approve the temporary change; however, he should consult with the Administrator of the State Engineer's Ground Water Division prior to acting on the request. (Recommendation of the Control Area Advisory Board will be required prior to approving a permanent change in well location). Approval for a temporary change shall not be given if there is a likelihood of injury to any other appropriator. In no case shall an increase in water use (yield, acres irrigated, area(s) or point(s) of use) by a temporary change be allowed. The superintendence shall forward copies of all temporary change requests and approvals to the State Engineer's and Board of Control Offices in Cheyenne.

If a permanent change is to be requested, a proper petition must be filed with the Board during the period of temporary change. The giving of an approval for a temporary change does not in any way guarantee that the State Board of Control will approve a permanent change.

A request for a temporary change must be made on the form and must be approved in writing by the appropriate superintendent prior to making the change. (SEE FORM ON REVERSE SIDE.)

The Superintendent, under W.S. 41-3-503 through W.S. 41-3-506, may allow temporary changes in certain instances where necessary for equal and fair distribution of water and administration of priorities.
