User (Shriner's) Responsibility:

<u>Clean-up</u>: Pick up trash between performances. User shall pay CAM-PLEX for the following:

a) Hire a cleaning crew to clean the mezzanine bleachers after the final performance to include picking up trash, sweeping and mopping. Rate \$400

b) Pay Cam-Plex for extra cleaning on main floor after the final performance to pickup trash, sweep and mop bleachers. Rate \$50

c) Cam-plex will designate two employees to mop up snow cone spills after each performance to avoid long term staining. No charge.

<u>Ticket Sales</u>: User responsible for pre-sales and door-sales.

<u>Tractor:</u> Verify tractor is in good condition and does not leak fluids as user responsible for

cleanup expense and damages. Shriner's will provide the concrete tie-downs and

move with tractor.

<u>City Permits</u> Obtain appropriate authorization for the carnival and wild animals permits.

Jordan's Circus Responsibility:

<u>Concessions:</u> Jordan's responsible for concession & coordinating with WY Beverage for pepsi products. Jordan's cannot sell gum or sunflower seeds, but can sell popcorn. Jordan's responsible for cleaning the concession room and contacting staff for an inspection prior to departure.

Equipment: Jordan's responsible for providing ring barriers.

North Loadout - if animals in this area during day...need to protect walls with plastic

ANIMALS IN WYOMING CENTER OVERNIGHT...needs Prior Authorization

If the Circus requests animals be indoors due to the cold weather, the Operations Manager must authorize this in advance, and the following conditions will apply:

- · Elephants or other approved animals allowed in North Load out;
- Miniature horses can be in North walkway;
- Other animal needs and locations will be discussed and authorized in advance.
- Circus must provide heavy duty plastic on walls
- One Circus employee can stay in building overnight (on cot with animals)
 - No other persons can be in the building.
 - o Elephants will be shackled
 - May need additional dumpster in North Lobby for animal waste
 - No other access in building besides authorized circus employee

CAM-PLEX will:

- Need Circus employee's name and cell phone number
- Will give circus employee our staff contact name & cell phone (Maintenance Staff on Call)
- Notify City Police Department of overnight authorization
- Notify all CAM-PLEX staff for safety and access reasons.
