TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF AGREEMENT

TERMS OF PAYMENT

In the absence of specific arrangements to the contrary, PCA Engineering, Inc. (PCA) will invoice the Client on a monthly basis. Such invoices are due and payable upon receipt. Any invoice not paid within 30 days of invoice date will be subject to a late fee of two percent (2%) per month from date of invoice until paid. The Client's obligation to pay for the work contracted is in no way dependent upon the Client's ability to obtain financing or upon Client's successful completion of the project. In addition, if payment is not received after thirty (30) days from date of invoice, or in the event of anticipating breach by Client, PCA may institute proceedings to file a lien upon the real estate which is subject of the project, pursuant to Wyoming Statutes, or may pursue other legal remedies available pursuant to law. In the event of default of payment by Client, and in the even PCA incurs expenses in the collection of the account from Client, Client shall reimburse PCA for those expenses including reasonable attorney's fees.

ACCESS

Client shall arrange for access to enter upon public and private property as required by PCA in order to provide the scope of services.

SAFETY

PCA shall not be held responsible for general safety of the Project site or for the work of other contractors or third parties.

OVERTIME

Overtime hours will be computed at 1.50 times the applicable rates. Overtime is defined as any hours over eight (8) per normal workday, or on weekends or holidays, or hours before 8:00 a.m. and after 5:00 p.m., which could not be performed at another time due to circumstances beyond the control of PCA.

MISCELLANEOUS

If the Client is a partnership or corporation, the individual or individuals executing this agreement on behalf of the Client, warrant that they are duly authorized agents of the Client and are empowered to so act.

If this is a Confirmation of Verbal Agreement and is not received back by PCA within five (5) working days, then it shall be considered a duly executed and confirmed contract.

This agreement is to be governed by the laws of the State of Wyoming.

Any and all liability, claim for damages, cost of defense or expense to be levied against PCA will be limited to a sum not to exceed the total amount of PCA's fee on account of injury or damage to persons or property, design defect, error, omission or professional negligence.

In the event the Client makes a claim against PCA, at law or otherwise for any alleged error, omission or other act arising out of the performance of professional services, and the Client fails to prove such claim, then the Client shall pay all costs, including attorney's fees incurred by PCA in defending itself against the claim.

Client shall pay all late fees, interest charges and collection costs.
