AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE DISTRICT ZONING MAP OF THE CITY OF GILLETTE, WYOMING, FOR UNPLATTED PROPERTY GENERALLY LOCATED AT 1500 MOONSHINER LANE, LEGALLY DESCRIBED AS A PORTION OF THE SW1/4 SW1/4 SECTION 29,

T50N, R72W
OF THE SIXTH PRINCIPAL MERIDIAN, CAMPBELL COUNTY, WYOMING,
FROM R-1, SINGLE FAMILY RESIDENTIAL DISTRICT,
TO R-S. SUBURBAN RESIDENTIAL DISTRICT.
