That the City of Gillette awards the bid to Titan Machinery of Gillette, Wyoming in the amount of \$204,047.82 for their bid on One New 2016 Six-Wheel Regenerative Air Street Sweeper.

Background

This is a replacement unit for Unit 9 that is assigned to the Streets Division. This replacement unit was originally approved in the FY14 budget, and the funds have been rolled over twice.

Note

Ameri-Tech failed to include a bid bond, which by Wyoming Statutes (WY 15-1-113 §F) prohibits us from accepting their bid.

Kois Brothers is a company from Montana, and Titan is from Wyoming which qualifies the latter for a 5% preference according to state statute (WY 16-6-102 §A).
