Warm Up Items

Councilman Montgomery reported on the recent pig wrestling event that he and Councilmen Barks, Carsrud, and Kuntz participated in.

Solid Waste Three-Yard Container Discussion

General discussion regarding three-yard containers took place. After the discussion, it was the consensus of the Council to allow for the removal of the three-yard containers from the alleys, replacing those containers with a roll out container for each resident in that area. Council directed staff to review the current ordinance, bringing back recommendations for the possibility of leaving roll outs in the alley.

Curbside Service Recycling Discussion

General discussion regarding curbside service recycling took place. After the discussion, Councilman Barks proposed that staff continue to work on a system for recycling, and include the possibility of using the private sector, bringing back recommendations for Council to consider. A majority of the Council was in agreement.

4-J Pathway (Near the Skate Park) Discussion

General discussion regarding the 4-J Pathway took place. After the discussion, Council directed staff to draft a letter to the County, regarding repairs to the 4-J Pathway.

6th Street (Between Burma and 4-J) Parking Discussion

General discussion regarding parking on 6th Street took place. After the discussion, Council directed staff to move forward with painting the curbs yellow to prevent parking in certain areas on 6th Street between Burma and 4-J Rd.

Review August 16th Agenda

The group reviewed the upcoming agenda items.

Executive Session

Councilman McGrath made a motion to move into an Executive Session to discuss personnel. Seconded by Councilman Carsrud. All voted aye. The motion carried.
