AN ORDINANCE TO ENACT THE ELECTRICAL LINE EXTENSION POLICY FOR THE CITY OF GILLETTE, TO AMEND SECTION 17-67 OF THE GILLETTE CITY CODE CONCERNING THE ELECTRICAL LINE EXTENSION POLICY AND REPEALING INCONSISTENT ORDINANCES AND RESOLUTIONS

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF GILLETTE, WYOMING:

SECTION ONE. The *Electrical Line Extension Policy*, including the 2016 *Electrical Standard Drawings*, for the City of Gillette is enacted to read as follows on the attached Exhibit A, which is incorporated herein by reference.

SECTION TWO. Section 17-67 of the Gillette City Code is amended to read as follows:

§17-67. Adoption of 2016 Electrical Line Extension Policy

The City of Gillette 2016 *Electrical Line Extension Policy*, prepared by the Electrical Engineering Division of the City of Gillette and adopted by Ordinance ____ passed approved and adopted on _____, and the 2016 *Electrical Standard Drawings* are hereby adopted by this reference and incorporated herein as if set out in full to regulate the design and extension of the City's electrical distribution and service line system within the City of Gillette. One copy shall be available for public inspection at the office of the Electrical Engineering Division and the office of the City Clerk during normal business hours. The Electrical Engineering Division will also provide copies for sale at a reasonable charge to cover the cost of preparation of the volume and has provided a copy for public review and download on the City's webpage.

SECTION THREE. Ordinance 1904, which enacted *The Electrical Distribution Standards*, and Ordinances 1912, 1958, 2045, 3087 and 3221 which amended *The Electrical Distribution Standards*, are repealed.

SECTION FOUR. Resolution 816, which adopted the *Utility Customer Service Drop Policy*, and Resolutions 986 and 1066, which amended the *Utility Customer Service Drop Policy*, are repealed.
