A RESOLUTION REGARDING THE SALE OF COMPOST BY THE CITY OF GILLETTE

WHEREAS, the City of Gillette as part of its operations of the Waste Water Treatment Plant, produces a solid by-product which may be converted for compost rather than disposed of in the landfill; and

WHEREAS, the City of Gillette also accepts appropriate yard waste within the community for purposes of converting to compost rather than being disposed of in the landfill; and

WHEREAS, the City of Gillette finds it appropriate to increase the sale price for compost from ten dollars (\$10.00) per cubic yard for "bio solid" compost and fifteen dollars (\$15.00) per cubic yard for "yard waste" compost, to twenty dollars (\$20.00) per cubic yard for all compost to reflect current market conditions and to make the operations of the compost program more economically sound and to limit losses in its operations; and

WHEREAS, the City likewise finds it necessary to limit the total amount of compost available to sale by any one person, entity or organization, to fifty (50) cubic yards per month in order to limit the resale of the City's discounted compost product.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF GILLETTE, WYOMING, the City shall charge the sum of twenty dollars (\$20.00) per cubic yard of compost sold by the City of Gillette, and no single person, entity, or organization shall be allowed to purchase more than fifty (50) cubic yards of compost from the City of Gillette within any given month.
