

A Pre-Meeting of the City Council was held on Tuesday the 4th day of April 2017.

Warm Up Items

Councilman Montgomery acknowledged and thanked the Rozet School for hosting a welcome home for veterans; Mayor Carter-King announced that her son, who plays hockey, was named Rookie of the Year; Administrator Napier announced the request and the receipt of an application to transfer a retail liquor license from Pat's Liquor to Walmart. The Council discussed the transfer schedule and after some discussion, it was decided to invite Walmart to the Work Session meeting on May 9th to present their business plan, and to schedule the public hearing for June 6th. Discussion regarding the scheduling of the three applicants applying for the available retail license(s) took place. It was decided to begin advertising for the public hearing, keep their presentations scheduled for May 2nd during the Pre-Meeting, and schedule the public hearing for May 16th.
