Pre-Corp Franchise Agreement Discussion

Utilities Director Cole provided an overview of the franchise agreement with PRE-Corp being proposed for consideration at the December 5, 2017 Council meeting to coincide with the third reading of the Ordinance for the Antelope Valley annexation area. An explanation of the franchise agreement, agreement term, franchise area and fee, responsibilities during the franchise term (PRE-Corp improvements, City improvements and street lights), easements/mapping, service transfer(s), legal aspects, and next steps were provided. City staff and PRE-Corp will continue to review and finalize the draft franchise agreement.
