**A RESOLUTION FOR THE BID AWARD OF THE SPECIAL
IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT #52 PROJECT, ENTITLED INTERSTATE
INDUSTRIAL PARK L.I.D. AND STREET IMPROVEMENTS**

WHEREAS, the City of Gillette, Wyoming (the “City”) is an incorporated municipality in the State of Wyoming; and

WHEREAS, the governing body of the City (the “Governing Body”) has previously ordered the improvements for the Special Improvement District No. 52, by Ordinance No. 3937, in the Subdivision commonly referred to as Interstate Industrial Park, for the construction and installation of a new water system and all necessary appurtenances (the “Water Improvements”); and

WHEREAS, the Governing Body has previously approved plans and specifications, drafted by the City Engineer for construction of the Water Improvements and associated street improvements (the “Project”), through Resolution No. 2642;

WHEREAS, the City has advertised the Project for bid for more than 30 days and held a public bid opening of the bids on January 25, 2018;

WHEREAS, a qualifying bid was received from DRM, Inc. in the amount of \$3,739,673.57 for the Project;

WHEREAS, the bid amount of \$1,589,999.00 for the Water Improvements bid Schedule B is less than the estimate of the contract price of \$1,705,512.00 in Ordinance No. 3937; and

WHEREAS, the design engineer, DOWL, reviewed the bids, qualifications, and experience of each of the bidding contractors and recommended the bid be awarded to the lowest bidder, DRM, Inc.

**THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY
OF GILLETTE, WYOMING:**

SECTION 1. The Governing Body does hereby declare its approval for the Bid Award for the Special Improvement District #52 Project, entitled Interstate Industrial Park L.I.D. and Street Improvements, as set forth by City Ordinance No. 3937, to DRM, Inc. in the amount of \$3,739,673.57.

SECTION 2. The Governing Body does hereby order the mayor to execute a written contract on behalf of the City with the successful bidder, DRM, Inc.
