

A Pre-Meeting of the City Council was held on Tuesday the 5th day of June 2018.

Present were Councilmen Barks, Carsrud, Kuntz, Montgomery, Neary, and Mayor Carter-King; City Administrator Davidson; City Attorney Reyes; Directors Aguirre, VonEye and Wilde; Lt. Wasson; Managers Palazzari, Toscana and Wasson; and City Clerk Abelseth.

Warm Up Items

Councilman Carsrud reported that he received a call regarding jake brakes being used in the Crestview area and asked if staff could look into this; he inquired about the compost at Wastewater; asked about the progress of the building on 12th Street that has fire damage; and asked about signage on Boxelder for the Sports Complex. Councilman Montgomery reminded everyone of the Children's Memorial Walkway Ceremony on June 9th.

Emergency Coordinator David King provided an update on the recent storm that produced four (4) tornados around the Gillette area, and the damages done by the tornados. A letter that was sent to those impacted by the tornados, allowing them four (4) free dumps, up to four (4) tons total, at the Campbell County Landfill, was provided. He also explained issues with the warning system. Mayor Carter-King stated that the City is willing to help where needed.

Telecommunication Ordinance Amendment & Fees Discussion

Development Services Director VonEye provided information regarding an amendment to the Telecommunication Ordinance.
