

A Pre-Meeting of the City Council was held on Tuesday the 6th day of November 2018.

Warm Up Items

Councilman Barks stated that he disagrees with WYDOT's engineering study regarding Hwy 50 and Boxelder Road; Administrator Davidson reported that the Huddle Up Group contacted Communications Manager Palazzari inquiring of dates that the Group can meet with the Council via a telephone conversation; Councilman Lundvall reported that the Campbell County Chamber's Awards event went very well.

1% Survey Resolution Discussion

Administrator Davidson provided a comparison of the 2014 1% Survey Resolution and the proposed 1% Survey Resolution. General discussion of the comparison ensued.

Chapter 14 Revision Discussion

Nikki Nellermoe, Community Service Supervisor, provided information regarding the proposed revisions to Chapter 14 relating to tobacco use, and citations issued to underage youth appearing in Municipal Court. Current penalties that could be imposed for underage use of tobacco, and proposed changes to the current Ordinance that would provide stiffer penalties for violations, were discussed. After the discussion, Council was in favor of moving forward with the proposed changes to the Ordinance providing stiffer penalties for violations.
