## Curling 2/9/2019

We are looking to close down Gillette Avenue from 0800 to 2200 on 2/9/2019. The closure would run from 1<sup>st</sup> Street (1<sup>st</sup> St would remain open) to the alley between the Center Bar and Big Lost Meadery (drive through traffic would remain intact). See map for details.

In addition to shutting down the street on the 9<sup>th</sup>, we are also looking to occupy the six northernmost parking spaces on Gillette Avenue's 1<sup>st</sup> Block. Three spaces on each side of the street would be closed from 2/7-9/2019. This way we can maximize our probability that we can make ice during that time. We will set up the curling rinks in those spaces and traffic will still be able to flow through Gillette Avenue. All ice will then be broken down on the evening of the 9<sup>th</sup> when curling has capitulated.

During this time we would have an open container permit that patrons could purchase alcohol from vendors on Gillette Ave and consume in the closed area. No alcohol purchases will occur on the street. We would also play the game of curling. Burn barrels would be offered for heat if needed.
