

A Pre-Meeting of the City Council was held on Tuesday the 19th day of March 2019.

Present were Councilmen Brown, Carsrud, Lundvall, McLeland, Neary, and Council President Montgomery; City Administrator Davidson; City Attorney Reyes; Directors Cole, Henderson; Managers Palazzari, Toscana, Schoen, and Tyrell; and City Clerk Staskiewicz.

Warm Up Items

Councilman McLeland commended City snow crews for their snow removal efforts that allowed road access to the emergency room for his family and many others during the blizzard.

Councilman Carsrud inquired about crash history at the intersection of Butler Spaeth Road and 12th Street. City Administrator Davidson stated that Staff would evaluate, gather data, and report back to Council.

Councilman Neary congratulated the local high school basketball teams for their success at the State Tournament.

Councilman Montgomery commended Administrator Davidson and Utilities Director Cole for a great job of explaining, to the Antelope Valley Home Owner's Association, the process and enforcement regarding the City's nuisance ordinance (Chapter 13) and how it differs from their subdivision covenants.

Councilman Neary stated that the early morning sun creates treacherous driving conditions on Lakeway Road near the water main break. Utilities Director Cole reported that Lakeway Road is now closed in that area until the repair is completed.
