A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING SUBMISSION OF AN ABANDONED MINE LAND PUBLIC FACILITIES GRANT APPLICATION TO THE WYOMING DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY, ABANDONED MINE LAND DIVISION ON BEHALF OF THE GOVERNING BODY FOR THE CITY OF GILLETTE, WYOMING FOR THE PURPOSE OF THE CITY OF GILLETTE WASTEWATER TREATMENT FACILITY ROADWAY ACCESS SAFETY IMPROVEMENT PROJECT.

W I T N E S S E T H

WHEREAS, the City of Gillette (“City”) desires to participate in the Abandoned Mine Land Public Facilities Grant Program to assist in financing the above-referenced project; and

WHEREAS, the City has identified the need for major improvements to the Wastewater Treatment Facility roadways due to public safety access issues, as well as dust mitigation issues; and

WHEREAS, the public benefit(s) of this project will be to keep access to the facility safe and accessible; and

WHEREAS, the specific goals and measures of success of this project include, but are not limited to, safer public roadway access in and out of the facility, as well as dust suppression; and

WHEREAS, the Abandoned Mine Land Public Facilities Grant program requires certain criteria be met, as described in the Wyoming Department of Environmental Quality’s rules governing the program and to the best of our knowledge this application meets those criteria; and

WHEREAS, the City has a comprehensive operation and maintenance plan including projected expenses and project income sources extending the life of the assets; and

WHEREAS, the City has considered other possible funding solutions for this project which include any potential for self-funding of the project; and

WHEREAS, the City held a public hearing on July 2, 2019 to elicit testimony from citizens and other concerned individuals in the community, and gave full consideration to all comments received; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF GILLETTE, WYOMING, that a grant application in the amount of Two Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$250,000) will be submitted to the Wyoming Department of Environmental Quality, Abandoned Mine Land Division to assist in funding the Wastewater Treatment Facility Roadway Access Safety Improvement Project.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that Joe Schoen, City Engineer is hereby designated as the authorized representative of the City of Gillette, Wyoming to act on behalf of the Governing Body on all matters including the execution of other necessary documents relating to this grant application and the project.
