

A Pre-Meeting of the City Council was held on Tuesday the 19th day of May 2020.

Warm Up Items

Councilman McLeland stated he received a citizen request for street sweeping in residential areas. Administrator Davidson stated that the residential street sweeping would begin in a few weeks. Administrator Davidson informed Council that there may be a possibility of future GPS tracking on street sweepers. Council discussed the recent bout of park graffiti in City Parks and at the County’s Skate Park. Councilman Lundvall informed of receipt of a letter from a local business owner in appreciation of information provided by the City Administrator and City Attorney; Councilman Lundvall commended Administrator Davidson and Attorney Reyes.

Games of Skill Ordinance Update

City Attorney Reyes reviewed background information relating to the Games of Skill Ordinance. Attorney Reyes reminded Council that the Wyoming Legislature recently passed a bill regulating the use of existing gambling devices through June 30, 2021. Unless further legislation is established beyond June 30, 2021, gaming devices would then be considered in violation of Wyoming law. Attorney Reyes recommended that Council not approve the 3rd reading of the Games of Skill Ordinance.
