

A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE PLACEMENT OF A LODGING
TAX QUESTION ON THE 2020 ELECTION BALLOT

WHEREAS, Wyoming Statute Section 39-15-203(a)(ii) authorizes a county, with voter approval, to impose a tax of up to four percent (4%) upon the sales price paid for lodging services, the primary purpose is for local travel and tourism promotion; and,

WHEREAS, the electors of Campbell County approved the imposition of a two percent (2%) lodging tax in 2016; and,

WHEREAS, there exists an opportunity to increase travel and tourism visitation and enhance the economy of Campbell County Wyoming.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF GILLETTE, WYOMING:

The City Council joins Campbell County Convention & Visitors Bureau in requesting the Campbell County Commission place the following question on the 2020 General Election ballot:

"Shall Campbell County impose a four percent (4%) lodging excise tax as set forth in Wyoming Statute 39-15-203(a)(ii), within Campbell County, Wyoming, on lodging services, which means the provision of sleeping accommodations to transient guests which shall include the providing of sites for the placement of tents, campers, trailers, mobile homes or other mobile sleeping accommodations for transient guests."
