A Pre-Meeting of the City Council was held on Tuesday the 21st day of July 2020 in the 2nd Floor Community Room.

Review July 21st Council Agenda

Acting City Administrator Cole reviewed the upcoming agenda items with the Mayor and Council.

Warm Up Items

Acting City Administrator Cole read a statement containing a brief COVID-19 update and provided information regarding proposed updates to the City's internal Infectious Disease Policy. The amended policy would require City employees to wear masks during work hours, when social distancing was not possible.

AMI Presentation

Mick Wolf, Electrical Services Superintendent, presented Council with information regarding an Advanced Metering Infrastructure pilot program that began in February of 2020. The program replaced 220 existing meters with advanced meters, which read the existing 1100 electric and 1000 water ERT's within the pilot area. Superintendent Wolf explained how the meters function, explained the benefits of the AMI meters, and stated that the pilot program was a success. In the current fiscal year, 2500 advanced meters and 4 collectors will be installed in monthly stages, beginning in the northwest section of the City.
