Current Definition of Group Care Facility

A facility or dwelling unit housing persons unrelated by blood, marriage or adoption and operating as a not-for-profit, housekeeping unit consisting of no more than six (6) client individuals and up to two (2) supervisor in the R-2 or R-3 zone No group care facility may house any person whose residency would constitute a direct threat to the health and safety of other individuals. It may include shelters for abuse victims and homes for handicapped or for disabled individuals. The current illegal use of or addiction to a controlled substance is neither a handicap nor a disability.

Mr. Davis Proposed Definition of Group Care Facility

A facility or dwelling unit housing persons unrelated by blood, marriage or adoption and operating as a housekeeping unit consisting of no more than six (6) client individuals and up to two (2) supervisors in the R-2, R-3, E-MH Enhanced Mobile Home, and M-H Mobile Home Residential Zoning Districts. No group care facility may house any person whose residency would constitute a direct threat to the health and safety of other individuals. It may include shelters for abuse victims and homes for handicapped or for disabled individuals. The current illegal use of or addiction to a controlled substance is neither a handicap nor a disability.

Staff Proposed Definition of Group Care Facility

A facility or dwelling unit housing persons unrelated by blood, marriage or adoption and operating as a operating as a not-for-profit or actively participating and in compliance with the State of Wyoming Medicaid Development Disability Waiver Program, housekeeping unit consisting of no more than six (6) client individuals and up to two (2) supervisors in all zoning districts where the primary use is residential. No group care facility may house any person whose residency would constitute a direct threat to the health and safety of other individuals. It may include shelters for abuse victims and homes for handicapped or for disabled individuals. All uses stated in the definition of Halfway House are not permissible and are considered outside the scope of the definition of Group Care Facility.
