## FIRST RENEWAL OF THE MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING BETWEEN CAMPBELL COUNTY, WYOMING AND THE CITY OF GILLETTE, WYOMING REGARDING FREE OPEN SWIM SESSIONS

- 1. **Parties.** This First Renewal of the Memorandum of Understanding Between Campbell County, Wyoming and the City of Gillette, Wyoming Regarding Free Open Swim Sessions ("Renewal") is made and entered into by and between Campbell County, Wyoming ("County"), through its Department of Parks and Recreation (collectively, "Department"), and the City of Gillette, Wyoming, ("City").
- 2. **Purpose.** On or about June 21, 2022, the parties entered into a Memorandum of Understanding Between Campbell County, Wyoming and the City of Gillette, Wyoming ("MOU"). The purpose of this MOU involved the Department providing free and open swim sessions during 2022 and 2023 summer seasons in exchange for payment from the City. The purpose of this Renewal is to extend the term of the MOU.
- 3. <u>Term of Renewal</u>. This Renewal is effective when all parties have executed it and all required approvals have been granted. The term of this Renewal is from May 28, 2024, through August 18, 2024.
- 4. <u>City Payment Obligation Under this Renewal.</u> The City's total payment obligation under this Renewal is forty thousand dollars (\$40,000.00). Payment shall be made upon submission of invoice pursuant to WYO. STAT. § 16-6-602. The Department will submit the invoice no sooner than July 1, 2024.
- 5. **No Further Changes: Incorporation of Terms.** All terms of the MOU not specifically modified by this Renewal remain unchanged and are incorporated as if fully set forth herein.
- 6. <u>Signatures</u>. The parties have executed to this Renewal through their duly authorized representatives on the dates set out below.
